ABOUT THE PROGRAM — 16 MONTH









Students attending this program learn both the technical and creative components of audio design and the business principles of the entertainment industry. This is a hands-on, project-based program, culminating in a major capstone project that draws upon the range of knowledge and skills learned throughout the program.

Associate of Applied Science students will be required to complete General Education classes including English Composition, World History, Introduction to Mathematical Modeling, Conceptual Physics, and Speech Communications.

This degree program consists of 16 courses taken in 16 months.
